## Definitions:

Call For Service (CFS) = any request for service or assistance received by CIEC911 and recorded on the CIEC911 CFS Log, whether or not a crime or other type of incident has occurred. A CFS may or may not . generate a report depending on the nature of the request

911 Abandoned / Hangup = any incoming telephone call received on the 911 Emergency line in which there was no one on the line or the caller indicates that they misdiale

Telephone Call = any incoming telephone line that is answered by CIEC911 staff which includes 911 telephone calls, non-emergency, abandoned/hangup, mis-directed, prank, etc

Vehicle Stop = a traffic stop initiated by RCIP and reported to CIEC911

License Check = a driver's license or vehicle registration check initiated by RCIP or another authorised law enforcement agency.
